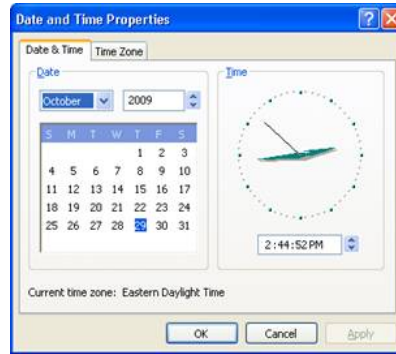


DID U KNOW?
